Embark on an "Owl Moon" winter tale adventure. Students will also create a watercolor painting inspired by the story and the February "Snow" full moon.

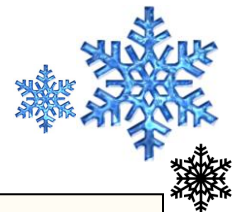
Snowed In? Let's Cook!
