## PROGRAM SCHEDULE (Register by March 8)

Indoor/Outdoor programs. Students should dress appropriately for the weather. Students do need to bring a lunch each day.

### Session 1: Monday, March 18 Art & Nature

Be an artist! Students will learn about and explore Missouri's outdoor native habitats and create art projects utilizing materials they find outdoors. Projects include designing a journey stick, creating a nature journal & more!

### Session 2: Tuesday, March 19 Green Chef

It is planting time! Students will learn about spring plants to grow in a garden, create their own mini garden and how to use what they grow to make delicious dishes!

### Session 3: Wednesday, March 20 Get Outdoors

Discover new ways to play OUTside! Investigate the signs of spring using tools that you can use in any local nature area (school yard, home, park, etc.). Join in the fun in becoming a Jr. Naturalist!

### Session 4: Thursday, March 21 Art & Nature II

Be an artist! Students will learn about and explore Missouri's outdoor native habitats and create art projects utilizing materials they find outdoors. Projects include creating a nature monogram, painting with watercolors & more!
